Dorset Fire and Rescue Service walking section will be holding their annual walking event, the Dorset Chesil Challenge on Sunday 13th may 2012

This year we have two circular routes of 20 and 14 miles respectively both starting and finishing at West Fleet Farm camping site (grid reference SY 624810) both walks take you into the Dorset countryside, to Portesham. And onwards to Hardy's Monument., the routes detour with the longer going to the monument, then rejoining the shorter route heading west along the SWCP to Abbotsbury. Along this path the routes split shorter one dropping into Abbotsbury and climbing to St Catherines Chapel. The longer one To Abbotsbury Castle, East Bexington Farm returns to Abbotsbury via SWCP . Both routes rejoin at the world famous Swannery , following the SWCP to the finish

The entry fee for the event will be nine pounds per walker. Entry on the day will be ten pounds. A memento and refreshments are included in the entry fee Cheques should be made payable to Dorset Fire and Rescue Service climbing section.

There is a limit of 200 walkers and unfortunately we are unable to cater for runners.

Refreshments will be supplied at selected checkpoints.

Rules and Conditions of Entry

1. The object of the walk is to complete your respective route visiting the checkpoints and marshal points, in order within a time limit of 10 hours.
2. Walkers under the age of 16 must be accompanied by a responsible adult.
3. Registration and issue of walk tallies will be from 0800 hours. All walkers to leave by 0900 hours.
4. NO WALKER IS ALLOWED TO 'DROP OUT'.
5. Walkers may retire at a checkpoint (C.P.) Not a marshal point (M.P.)
6. Walkers who retire are to hand in their walk tallies to the checkpoint controller. The walker will then be transported to the finish when convenient.
7. Those walkers who have completed the walk MUST ensure that the tallies are handed in to the checkpoint controller before departure.
8. Walk tallies that are lost MUST be reported to someone at a checkpoint or marshal point.
9. All walkers will observe the *Country Code* and the *Highway Code*
10. In the event of injury, render all possible assistance, leave the casualty with company, and inform the nearest checkpoint/marshal point as soon as possible, giving details of the injuries and the location of the casualty, providing a Grid Reference if possible.
11. All instructions and directions given by walk officials must be followed.
12. All walkers/groups of walkers must carry the following;
 - OS Land ranger Map 194 Dorchester and Weymouth or
 - OS Explorer OL 15 Purbeck and South Dorset
 - Compass
 - Whistle
 - First Aid Kit
 - Suitable waterproof clothing
13. Walkers taking part in this event do so at their own risk NO LIABILITY can be accepted by the organisers in the event of an accident and/or injury to a participant however caused.
14. No runners.
15. Due to the ground conditions being muddy around the year suitable footwear is required
16. Well behaved dogs are permitted on the walk
